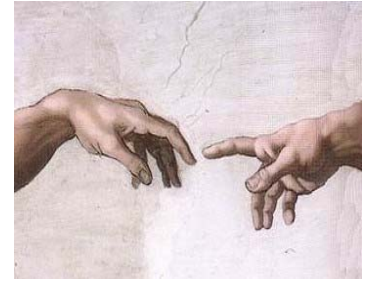

Fr. Joseph Dorniak, OFM, Conv. is a native of Bridgeport, CT and entered the Conventual Franciscan Order in 1969. He holds a B.A. in Philosophy and a Masters of Theology. Fr. Joseph has taught religion at the High School level; served as parochial vicar at several parishes; served as Director at the Franciscan Hermitage Retreat Center; chaplain for two nursing homes; and was privileged to work in West Africa, and to pastor mission Churches in Jamaica. He is currently ministering at the Shrine of St. Anthony in Ellicott City, MD and at a nearby nursing home.

Fr. Joseph is also widely known for his artistic gifts, publishing graphics and painting murals worldwide. His latest project is a mural of St. Francis of Assisi receiving the Sacred Stigmata at the Shrine of St. Anthony where he resides.
