Fr. Corbett has been a member of the Order of Preachers since 1974. He was ordained to the priesthood in 1980. He completed his Licentiate in Sacred Theology in 1981 and received his PhD in Moral Theology from University of Fribourg in Switzerland. He has been in Campus Ministry, taught at Providence College and the Josephinum, and currently teaches Moral Theology at the Dominican House of Studies in Washington, DC. Father is an experienced retreat director.
