The retreat weekend will run from 7:15 p.m. Friday to 12:00 p.m. Sunday. The program includes all meals on Saturday and breakfast on Sunday. Accommodations are single rooms with showers and lavatories on each hall. Please plan to bring neat, comfortable clothing, a bathrobe, and slippers.
