

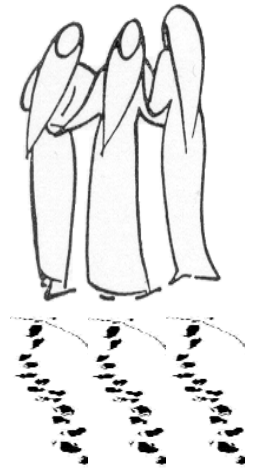

Walking with Women in the Gospels

Each year, Dominican Retreat selects a Scripture phrase to use as the theme for the retreat weekend.

Our 2010 theme, "Walking with Women in the Gospels," will focus on the insights these women offer on how to age with grace. The theme offers retreatants a touchstone for personal prayer and reflection while on retreat. The Director's talks and Sisters' prayer services will incorporate the theme as a source of inspiration for retreatants.

At some point during retreat a subtle change occurs. Perspectives shift and an individual's life and purpose come back into focus. Retreatants leave the weekend feeling refreshed in mind, body, and spirit and with a greater sense of clarity.

The weekend includes:

- Daily talks by the Director
- Prayer Services & Daily Mass
- Opportunity for Confession
- Rosary
- Stations of the Cross
- Small Groups
- Opportunity to meet with the Director and Sisters one-on-one

The Director:

Fr. Robert Finamore is a priest of the Archdiocese of Washington. He has been ordained almost forty years. Father has Masters Degrees in Divinity and Social Work & Gerontology. He has been giving retreats for 16 years, to both lay and religious women. After serving several parishes in the Archdiocese, Father recently retired from ministry.

Suggested offering for a weekend retreat is \$250; a deposit of \$75 is requested with your reservation. The deposit is non-refundable, but may be transferred to another retreat for up to one year.
