### **The Director:**

**Fr. Patrick McMahon, O. Carm.** is a Carmelite friar and Catholic Priest. He is the director of the Carmelitana Collection, a specialized research library in spirituality maintained by the American Carmelites in Washington, DC. He also is a professor of spirituality at the Washington Theological Union. In addition to giving retreats and programs, he assists regularly at a number of local churches and is a regular preacher at St. Matthew's Cathedral in downtown Washington.

Suggested offering for a weekend retreat is \$250; a deposit of \$75 is requested with your reservation. The deposit is non-refundable, but may be transferred to another retreat for up to one year.
