Preparing for retreat

We ring a rising bell each day but if you prefer an alarm, please bring an alarm clock. Many people find it useful to bring a journal for writing during retreat.

The Director:

Fr. Bart Karwacki, a Conventual Franciscan Friar, was ordained in 1975. He currently resides at St. Joseph Cupertino Friary in Ellicott City, Maryland and serves as the Provincial, Regional, and Local Spiritual Assistant to the Secular Franciscans. Fr. Bart provides individual spiritual direction, parish missions, and conducts retreats and days of recollection for priests, religious, and lay persons.

The suggested offering for a weekend retreat is \$250. We ask for \$75.00 as a deposit with your reservation. The deposit is non-refundable, but may be transferred to another retreat for up to one year. Our policy is to welcome all people regardless of their ability to pay. We rely on donations to cover the difference between our actual cost and the average offering we receive. Including a donation with your offering will enable someone less fortunate to come on retreat. Payment can be made by check or credit card.
